

Admit, Accept & Declare The Truth

Have the person you are ministering to . . .

- Admit & accept the truth about how they feel – “their truth”
- Declare (verbalize aloud) God’s Truth & accept that it’s “His Truth”
- Admit & accept truth about what happened to them
- Admit & accept the truth about what they participated in or experienced
- Admit (confess) any sins committed or omitted as the Holy Spirit reveals them

Renouncing Lies & Unrighteous Effects

In regard to lies, have the person your ministering to say or repeat something like . . .

“In Jesus’ Name, I renounce (reject) the lie that _____ and I accept God’s Truth that says . . .”

In regard to things participated in, experienced, or associated with . . .

“In Jesus’ Name, I renounce (cut off) all spiritual influences associated with _____ (sin committed or committed against them, acts of unrighteousness, sexual unions; traumatic experiences, forms of idolatry, evil influences through association with things or people, etc.)”

Canceling the Effects of Unrighteousness and Evil

Prayer Minister: And, in Jesus’ Name, I (we) cancel all effects and influences that came about through, or as a result of _____, and send them away from (him/her) and to Christ for His judgment. Lord Jesus, we ask you to restore and protect every part of their being that has been affected.”

Take Thoughts Captive To Make Them Obedient to Christ

Person Receiving Prayer: “Lord Jesus, I submit my mind, thoughts and feelings to your control so I can know your truth. I claim the “mind of Christ” you’ve given me and in Jesus’ Name, suspend and forbid any form of deception. Holy Spirit I give you this thought (or feeling) and ask you to show me the truth that leads to freedom.”

Forgiving & Releasing Your Offender

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal those they need to forgive; the specific offenses they need to forgive them for. As these come to mind have the prayer recipient pray or repeat something like: “Lord Jesus, I now **forgive** (name of offender) for

_____.

I **acknowledge** that their sins and the results of their actions affected my life (allow them to describe) and (made/make) me feel _____.”

“I now **release** (name of offender) and the sins they’ve committed against me to you Lord Jesus, the only righteous judge. I **renounce**, and ask you Lord to free me from all effects and influences of evil that came through the sins committed against me and through harboring unforgiveness in my heart. I now forgive just as you have forgiven me, in Jesus’ Name, amen.”
